FINAL CALL FOR DUTY

A Nightingale Lamp is lit in the nurse's honor and the nurse's name is called out with a request to report for duty. With no response, the nurse's name is repeated twice more with the same request. After the third and final call the nurse's name is retired, and the lamp's flame is extinguished.

CASKET HONOR GUARD
